

## Materials list Documents Security

You will spend some time practising the script of your choice, so bring your usual writing gear.

That is paper, nibs, ink and exemplars.

To make seals, they will be about the size of a 10 cent piece. You will need something to make an impression into the modelling clay about this size. Something that has a distinctive pattern eg coin, button with raised design, an earring, shell, gumnut. Some options will be provided.

Sealing wax if you have it

Seals if you have any

A lighter or candle for melting sealing wax.

A3 and A4 paper for the folding of the letters, a few sheets of each, copy paper is fine, practice sheets are good, and some pre written letters best (but optional)

Bone folder

Pva glue

String or embroidery thread

A few colourful lettering discards or small coloured paper scraps

Awl if you have one

Ruler, pencil, scissors, cutting blade and mat
