

Materials List

For painting

Some calico and black cotton will be supplied

- Other fabrics you might like to bring - calico, cotton drill, curtain lining, hessian, muslin, organza, clothing, florist ribbon, tissue paper.
- Paper – 100gsm +
- Plastic for tables, apron
- Masking tape
- Paper to make small stencils. Copy paper is fine
- Stencil knife or Stanley knife (a stencil knife has a finer blade)
- Acrylic paint including black and white. Waterproof ink in black
- Fabric paints if you have them.
- Textile medium if you have some. This can be added to acrylic paint, then ironed to make a washable piece.
- Water container and plate for mixing colours.
- Small jar for mixing runny paint
- Assortment of brushes – include a wide 2cm brush (the older the better)
- Sponges – small to be used for stencilling, dishwashing type that have the scourer on one side
- Paper towel
- newspaper
- Few stamps, readymade plastic stencils (optional but could be useful)
- Improvised implements for drawing with paint – sticks (interesting broken ends), cardboard, old plastic card etc
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Few embroidery threads and needles
- kitty litter tray or similar (for washing stencils, stamps, sponges)
- cutting board

For lettering

- 1cm wide flat brush, your good one for lettering
- gouache
- An exemplar of a script you would like to write

For sewing

- Sewing machine
- Pins and sewing tools
- Threads

Other items depending on what you want to make

- Book boards
- Light interfacing - if you have it
- Glue
- Cards
